Jaishankar calls UN a frozen 1945-invented mechanism

Says It's Unable To Articulate Wider Concerns Of Its Membership

New Delhi: India on Friday vowed to work towards building a consensus among the G20 nations for a green development pact to facilitate investments in sustainable lifestyle and pitched for larger discussions on "data for development" to bridge digital divide among various countries.

In a virtual address at a session of the Voice of the Global South Summit, External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar flagged unsustainable debt, trade barriers, contracting financial flows and climate pressure as some of the key challenges facing the developing countries.

knock-on effects of the Ukraine conflict, Jaishankar said it further complicated the economic situation as the costs and availability of fuel, food and fertilisers has emerged as a major concern for "many of us".

"So too has the disruption in trade and commercial services. However, none of this has got the attention that it deserves in global councils. Where the United Nations is concerned, a frozen 1945-in-

ister said India, during its G20 presidency, would commit to drive a consensus on a Green Development Pact of the G20 Leaders, noting that it will be a "blueprint of strong actions" for the next decade powering Green Development all over the world.

"This will be through investments in sustainable lifestyle, leveraging green hydrogen for climate action, and accelerating progress on SDGs," he said at the session on "G20 of the Voice of the Global South Summit 2023".

Sharad Yadav's last rites to take place in his MP village today

Bhopal: The last rites of veteran socialist leader and former Janata Dal (United) president Sharad Yadav will take place at his ancestral village in Madhya Pradesh's Narmadapuram district on Saturday, his close associate said here on Friday.

The former Union minister died on Thursday at a private hospital in Gurugram at the age of 75.

Former JD (U) Madhya Pradesh unit head and a close associate of Sharad Yadav, Govind Yadav said the veteran politician's last rites will be performed at his ancestral village Ankhmau by road. The last rites will be at 1:30 pm," he said. The last rites will be performed by Sharad Yadav's son Shantanu Bundela, the late politician's nephew, Shailesh Yadav, informed. After starting out as a student leader, Sharad Yadav's LS byelection victory from Jabalpur in MP in 1974 as opposition candidate against then ruling Congress catapulted him into national politics.

Delhi hit-&-drag: II cops suspended for 'negligence'

New Delhi: On the MHA recommendation, the Delhi Police on Friday suspended 11 police personnel for their alleged negligence while being on duty, when the gruesome accident occurred in the city's Kanjhawala on January 1.

The case pertains to the gruesome January 1 incident in which 20-year-old Anjali Singh, who was riding a scooter, was found dead on the street after being allegedly hit and dragged for several kilometres by a car driven by five youths in Outer Delhi's Kanjhawala area.

"As approved by the competent authority, a total of 11 Policemen of Rohini District deployed enroute at PCRs and pickets have been suspended," the Delhi Police said. Notably, among the suspended police personnel, five were on two pickets and six personnel were on three Police Control Rooms (PCRs) who have been suspended. Earlier on Thursday, the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) took cognizance of the detailed Delhi Police report prepared by Special Commissioner of Police Shalini Singh, the ministry recommended suspending police personnel deployed in three PCR vans and at two police pickets. These police personnel were on duty at the time of the incident. Besides, the MHA recom-

Tirumala Balaji temple records ₹1.5k cr as 2022 hundi collection

Tirupati (AP): The Lord Venkateswara swamy shrine on the Tirumala hills here, considered as the world's richest Hindu temple, has earned over Rs 1,450 crore in 2022 by way of offering (hundi collections) from devotees.

According to Dharma Reddy Executive Officer of Tirumala Tirupati Devasathanams (TTD), as many as 2.37 crore devotees visited the temple last year. The shrine received Rs 833.41 crore as Hundi Collection and the number of devotees visited stood at 1.04 crore in 2021.

"2.37 crore devotees visited the shrine in 2022. Hundi collections were at Rs 1,450.50 crore." Reddy told media persons in a press conference. A senior official of the temple administration told PTI that the figures are not comparable as most part of the 2021 and beginning of 2022 were under COVID-19 restrictions. The TTD official figures state that in December alone, the TTD got Rs 129.37 crore towards Hundi collections and the number of devotees who visited the Lord Balaji temple stood at Rs 20.25 lakh. Till January 11 this year, over six lakh devotees visited the temple and offered Rs 39.40 crore in the Srivari Hundi. The TTD told 11.54 lakh Laddu Prasadam in 2022 as against 5.96 lakh in the previous year.

6-mth power, water bill waiver for those affected in Joshimath

Dehradun: The Uttarakhand government on Friday decided to waive for six months electricity and water bills of families and individuals affected in the subsidence-hit Joshimath.

It also decided to conduct a study on the carrying capacity of all towns located in the hills. The decisions were taken at a meeting of the state cabinet here chaired by Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami. The cabinet gave an in-principle approval to the construction of prefabricated houses for short-term rehabilitation of the affected people of Joshimath at identified locations in Koti Farm, Pipalkoti, Gauchar, Gaukh SeLang, and Dhak villages after their survey. It also decided to put on hold repayment of bank loans owed by the affected people for one year. The cooperative banks will implement the one-year moratorium on repayment of loans immediately, while the state government will request the Centre to ask commercial banks to take a similar measure for the affected people in Josh-

imath, chief secretary SS Sandhu said at a press conference after the cabinet meeting. The cabinet decided to increase the amount being given by the state government to the affected families to pay rent from Rs 4,000 per month to Rs 5,000 per month. It also authorised the Chief Minister to increase it further on the recommendation of the District Magistrate. People in Joshimath have been complaining that for Rs 4,000 rent is too low. Each affected family staying in temporary relief camps built in hotels and residential units will be paid Rs 850 per room per day for their accommodation besides Rs 450 per head per day for expenses.
